So people in Subud don't just seek spiritual knowledge. We live as normal people and we pursue our respective professions, and at the same time we seek spiritual understanding.



This is why Bapak made the decision to set up a Subud wing called the Subud International Cultural Association, or SICA.

Bapak hoped that through SICA, Subud members who had a TALENT in a particular field would create something truly new or different, something that would touch other people, meaning people who are not in Subud, people outside Subud.

So in this way, through SICA, we can provide proof to people who are not in Subud.

Inspiration & clues for action

"By creating something for *other people*, you may be able to demonstrate something that, without their being aware of it, may exert a positive influence on people who are not in Subud.

So we hope that **Subud will spread through SICA**— through activities that other people can see. This is particularly hoped for from young members who have a lot of energy - that they will generate something new that will also be a part of SICA's activities.

Of course, we need to train for this too (in latihan), as not every member can understand yet what SICA is for.

SICA is for activities that grow out of the development of the soul."
